Mandate

The Academic Coordinating Committee is the body with overall responsibility for the integrity of the undergraduate degree programs in the Faculty.

Membership:

- Associate Dean (Academic) ACC Chair
- Assistant Dean (Academic and Student Programs)
- Department Chairs (4)
- 4 professors (Selected by Associate Dean (Academic) from academic advisors)
- 4 undergraduate students selected by ALES students. One student must come from each of the following categories:
 - 1. Nutrition and Food Science;
 - 2. Human Ecology;
 - 3. Environmental and Conservation Sciences, BA Environmental Studies, Forestry, or Forest Business Management
 - 4. Agriculture, Animal Health, or Agricultural/Food Business Management

Specific Responsibilities and Jurisdiction:

- Approves course cancellations
- Approves new courses based on supporting information, including detailed course syllabus and letter of support from Department(s) proposing the new course
- Establishes course viability standards (enrollment, program needs, etc.) and reviews courses accordingly
- Approves University Calendar changes, as delegated by Faculty Council
- Identifies and discusses teaching and learning issues related to undergraduate programs
- Meets twice a term and once in summer and additionally as necessary
