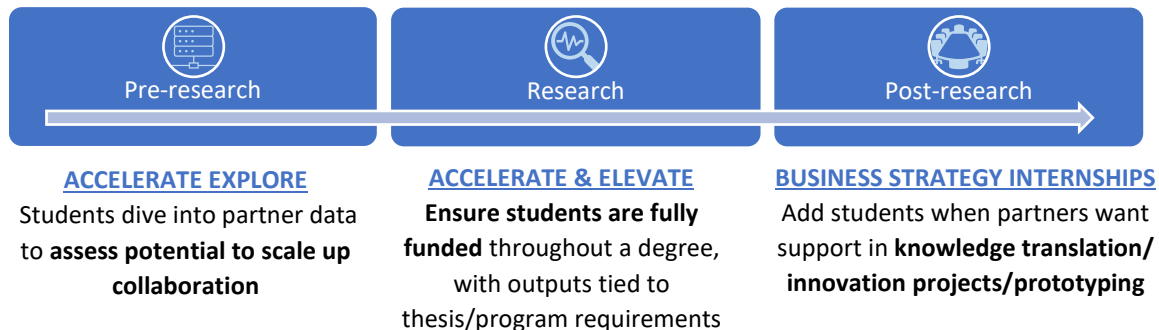
Are you developing large-scale research, education, and training collaborations like Mitacs funding?

Mitacs can fund your entire research program (up to 5 years+) through a tailored funding model approach with eligible cash-match partners that can support all your students on single (or multiple) applications, where applicable. **An application can have multi-students (named and unnamed spots), multi-professor, multi-academic institution and/or multi-partners.**

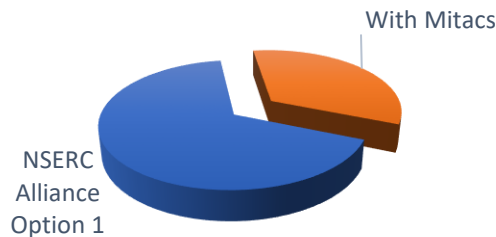

Boost NSERC Alliance (Option 1) existing partner cash matches by an additional 30%-50% with a joint Mitacs submission

Leverage up to 3:1 for small to large scale initiatives with existing partner and NSERC Alliance Option 1 cash contributions

Example of Joint Collaborations	Are you accessing these opportunities?
SSHRC award recipients and Mitacs	Secure SSHRC PEG, PDG, PDG1, and PDG2, or Insight grants, and fast track the reviews for Mitacs funds to match partner cash contributions
NSERC Alliance Option 1/ Mitacs Accelerate joint application	Match all partner contributions with Mitacs to increase the size and scope of your NSERC Alliance Option 1's and secure up to 3:1 leverage. Must be for a new application
NSERC Create award recipients and Mitacs	NSERC Create grant recipients get fast track reviews on associated Accelerate awards

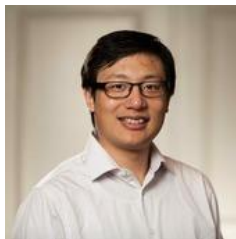
